Our July Mission March on Sunday, July 14 will support Love INC who have an urgent need for financial support.

Love INC – Big Woods is being stretched financially, almost to the breaking point and are reaching out to their partner churches for an extra, emergency donation to help them get back on track. Many factors contributed to this shortage. Their Transitional Home experienced winter damage that required repair, donations in general have declined, and some grants have come to an end.

Here is how they've helped those who were facing hard times in 2018: \$10,500 worth of furniture was delivered, \$8,248 in auto repair services was provided, gas cards totaling \$1,025 were distributed, and transportation was provided to the elderly. During the last quarter of 2018, 230 adults were served from 165 families; 182 children were served, primarily from single parent homes.
