The leftover items from our earlier packing night in Annandale were taken as “seed” for the Montrose effort, and boy did that seed take hold and sprout. After the first night of packing the Montrose group found that they had an extra 16 washcloths. Someone said, let’s do 16 more! So we put out a call for more items, and after Sunday worship we put together an extra 16 kits!

The kits were picked up after worship on October 27th, and taken to the conference office. From there they will be taken to one of our three UMCOR depots, one in Illinois, one in Utah, and the original depot, Sager Brown in Louisiana.
